All abstracts will be reviewed for content. Authors will be notified of acceptance and time slot by mail or e-mail.

Specifications include:

A. Limit of two pages (8½" x 11") including illustrations and references

B. Use 9-11 (10-12 pitch) type, left margin of 1.5", top, bottom, and right margins of 1"

C. Use GSA or GAC-MAC-SEG style for the abstract, title, author(s) name, affiliation and cited references

D. Preferably provide a digital copy (in MS Word® or .pdf format) on disk or by e-mail; maps and diagrams must be in .jpg or .tif format. Abstracts and illustrations may also be provided in hard copy.

E. Authors must submit one camera-ready abstract and one copy for review; maps and diagrams must be legible. **Electronic submission in camera ready PDF is encouraged.**
